PUBLIC WORKSHOP TO BE HELD ON DOW ROAD CORRIDOR STUDY *Public input will help shape the future widening and extension of Dow Road in Carolina and Kure beaches*

WILMINGTON - The Wilmington MPO will hold a public workshop to discuss the Dow Road Corridor Study in Carolina and Kure beaches. The study will consider widening Dow Road from US 421 in Carolina Beach to K Avenue in Kure Beach, as well as extending Dow Road from K Avenue to US 421 (Fort Fisher Boulevard) on new location.
