Changes in Town Hall Staffing

Kure Beach residents will be seeing some changes in Town Hall staffing soon. In fact, one of the changes has already taken place. Ms. Nancy Hewitt has returned to Town Hall as the Customer Service Representative. Ms. Hewitt is resuming the position she held until August of 2009.

Other changes in Town Hall staffing were necessary after the Town Administrator resigned. Since December, the Town Council has been working to distribute the duties and managerial responsibility of the Town Administrator to other staff working within Town Hall. As part of the changes in management structure, Ms. Nancy Avery will be returning to Kure Beach as Town Clerk effective June 21, 2010. Ms. Avery previously served as Kure Beach Town Clerk from 2006 to 2008, prior to the hiring of the Town Administrator.

The Town Council is also looking for an experienced Finance Director to assume the financial duties previously held by the Town Administrator. It is hoped that the new Finance Director will be in place soon after the start of the new budget year on July 1, 2010.

A side benefit to these staffing changes is that Town Hall staff will be reduced from 7 employees in 2009 to 5 employees in 2010 with no reduction in Town Hall services. The new staffing arrangements will save Kure Beach taxpayers over \$50,000 per year in salaries and benefits.
