USE CAUTION**


Red

LOCAL RULES & REGULATIONS STRICTLY ENFORCED

- **Dogs** are not allowed on the beach from April 1 through September 30. **\$150 FINE**
- **Leash Law:** All dogs are required to be on a leash or restraint with lead line not to exceed 15' in length. **\$150 FINE**
- **Pet Waste:** Section 4-16-1 requires all dog owners to clean up after their pets. The ordinance also requires that a "means of disposal" be carried by any person walking a dog. **\$150 FINE**
- **Alcohol is Prohibited** on the beach strand at all times and in public elsewhere throughout the town. **\$50 FINE**
- **Trespassing** on sand dune areas is prohibited. Generally, any area with sea grass growing is a protected dune. **\$100 FINE**
- **No Swimming or Surfing** within 250 yards of either side of the Kure Beach Fishing Pier. Dangerous conditions exist. **\$25 FINE**
- **Fires and Grills** are prohibited on the beach strand. **\$100 FINE**
- **Beach Equipment** (volleyball nets, chairs, cabanas, fishing gear, etc.) is not allowed to be left on the beach between the hours of 7pm and 8am. It will be removed and disposed of by the town. **\$50 FINE**
- **No Tents, Chairs, Etc.,** allowed within 15 feet of the dune line. **\$50 FINE**
- **Vehicles** on the beach are prohibited. **\$25 FINE**
- **Littering** including cigarette butts is prohibited. Trash receptacles are located at each public access. **\$150 FINE**
- **Digging ANY Size Hole on the beach is Dangerous.** Do NOT leave holes unattended and fill them in prior to leaving the beach. **\$100 FINE**

*NOTE: Our rules and regulations are in place to protect and serve our residents, visitors and environment. Please respect our town!
