

OUR LIFEGUARDS are on duty from Memorial Day weekend to Labor Day weekend, 7 days a week, from 9 am to 5 pm, weather permitting. *LIFEGUARD FLAGS:* Green-calm conditions; Yellow-use caution; Red-use extreme caution (rip tides); Black-no lifeguard on duty.

OUR BEACH ACCESS POINTS (north to south) Ocean View Avenue, Spotters Court, N, M, L, K, J, I, H, G, F and E Avenues and Davis Road. Wheelchair ramps are located on N, L, J, I, G, F and E Avenues and Davis Road.

OUR BEACH WHEELCHAIRS can be reserved for up to a week. These are manual-push chairs with wheels that are designed to handle sandy terrain. To reserve a wheelchair, call 910-458-2014; pickup at Firehouse behind Town Hall.

BULK TRASH PICKUP is every Thursday. Call Public Works to get on their list. Acceptable trash items are old furniture, yard debris and miscellaneous items. DON'T bag yard debris or mix it with other materials. Unacceptable trash items are shingles, tires, asbestos products, building materials, or hazardous waste (toxic, flammable, corrosive or reactive materials).

*GARBAGE & RECYCLING PICKUP

MONDAY - Fort Fisher Boulevard, Atlantic Avenue, Spotters Court and properties south of K Avenue, including the south side of K Avenue. TUESDAY - all other properties north of K Avenue, including the north side of K Avenue. **See enclosed garbage/recycling pickup schedule for schedule variances due to holidays.* Garbage and Recycling Carts can be wheeled to your property line at 6:00 pm the night before pickup and must be wheeled back to your house by Midnight after pickup. Garbage carts cost \$80 each and will be charged on your utility bill. Call Town Hall to order.

UTILITY BILLS are mailed out the last day of each month, and payment is due on the 15th of each month to avoid a late fee. Payments can be made via credit/debit card by phone, at Town Hall, or via the Town's website for an extra 3% fee. Checks made out to Town of Kure Beach, and cash, are also accepted. Drop-off payment box is located in Town Hall parking lot.

ANNUAL VEHICLE TAX DECAL

Bring your vehicle registration to Town Hall and pay your annual vehicle tax. Tax is \$5 from January 2nd to March 31st. Add a \$10 penalty fee if paid after March 31st. Non-resident property owners may purchase decals for \$5, year-round.

TOWN PERMITS are required for the following items: buildings, signs, fences, landscaping, demolition, special events, party tents, and yard sales. Forms are online under Services > Permits on the Town's website, as well as at Town Hall.

TOWN ORDINANCES

You can view all of the Town's ordinances via the Town website. See information on "*Quick Links*" on the back of this brochure.

If you see a law or ordinance being violated, call 911. The dispatcher will radio the Kure Beach police to respond, even if it's not an emergency. For general KBPD inquiries, please call their office during regular office hours.

MISCELLANEOUS ISSUES

If a street light is out, call Town Hall with the pole location and pole number. We will report it to Duke Energy.

If your recycling pickup was missed, call Town Hall. We will report it to Waste Management.

TOWN COUNCIL

Kure Beach Town Council meets the third Tuesday of each month at 6:30 pm. If you wish to address Council, please sign up at the podium before the meeting starts.

COMMUNITY INVOLVEMENT

If there is a member vacancy on a Town committee and you are a full-time resident, we invite you to apply to become a member. Vacancies are posted on the Town's bulletin board at Town Hall. Applications are available on the Town's website under Government > Committees, as well as at Town Hall.
