
No one appeared to address the council.

Commissioner comments:

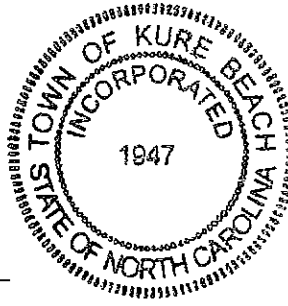
Commissioner Lambeth stated that the because the ordinance limits the number of copies provided, staff time and resources are wasted having to make extra copies which are generally needed.


Mayor Fuller asked where the required number of copies would be stated. Inspector Batson replied it would be handled as an internal procedure process.
