Mayor Montgomery stated:

- that the Town received a letter from the law firm of Smith, Moore, Leatherwood LLP representing the Beachwalk Home Owner's Association regarding storm water retention.
- The Town's storm water committee recommended that the Town not contribute to the cost of bringing the retention pond up to the North Carolina Department of Environment and Natural Resources (NCDENR) standards or recertification.
- At their January 2008 meeting, The Town Council voted no, that the Town would not contribute funds.


Town Attorney Canoutas stated:

- Permitting was done by the State and the Town has no obligation in this matter.


