*OLD BUSINESS:*

- A. Sandman Project. This project is still on hold.*
- B. Standard Signs;. This project is still on hold.*
- C. Atlantic Avenue. The work on the new walkway is progressing. At the May meeting the committee was presented with a landscaping proposal from RTM Landscapers. The committee asked Ms. Clark to present the proposal to Council as Chair Withrow was unavailable.*

*On May 29, 2009 e-mails regarding RTM, the landscaping projects, and other related items were circulated. To clarify this situation the Committee has made the following recommendation:*

*The Beautification Committee advises the Council and Staff that the \$895.00 for the delivery and installation of flowers at the Town Hall entranceway comes out of the present budget of which there is still \$3,000.00 available. At the April Council meeting the Mayor and council advised the Beautification Committee to pay for the project and not to bring it back to Council.*

*The Committee sincerely hopes this settles this problem.*

*The committee has asked Chair Withrow to present the Council with the Landscaping plan. Chair Withrow is scheduled to make this presentation at the next Council meeting on June 16<sup>th</sup>.*

*NEW BUSINESS:*

- A. Bob Falco, regarding the committee charter. Mr. Falco was unable to attend this meeting and will be rescheduled at the July meeting.*
- B. Tree City. Bob Falco is reviewing the information and will advise the committee when he has completed his review.*

*MEMBERS COMMENTSS:*

*John Gordon addressed the committee regarding the gaillardia plants. He has been working with the Aquarium to cultivate the wild gaillardia. There has been some success in this project and the plants are ready to be planted. He recommends planting them by the tennis courts. Mr. Nelder will speak with Mr. Lambert and Sonny about preparing the location. When ready, Mr. Gordon and Mrs. Smith will plant them.*
