The committee would like a natural color. Chuck will check with Sonny about obtaining two small pieces one painted white the other natural, place the town crest decal on each to see which one we should use. SLAP is in the process of obtaining (P) parking signs for the town. They will use the post that is approved by the Beautification Committee.*
- C. Atlantic Ave landscape. The present maintenance contract is due to expire shortly. The Town will be taking over the maintenance. Candace has already drawn up a schedule for this.*
