

KURE BEACH COMMUNITY CENTER MINUTES
JUNE 10, 2014

The June 10, 2014 meeting of the Kure Beach Community Center was called to order at 10 a.m. Members present were: Harriet Owsley, Jeannie Gordon, Mararuth Capell, Barbara Boal, Robin Sack, Lore Eccleston, Pat Slachetka, Craig Bloszinsky (Town Council Representative) and , and Nicole Keely (Town Recreation Coordinator.)

The May 13, 2014 minutes were approved.

Jeannie Gordon gave the financial report. For May, 2014 we received income from the AKIDO group in the amount of \$200 for the month. Jeannie also reported that we have three (3) rentals coming in the near future. (Dates were not available at this time).

We had an expense of \$380 for the cleaning of the entire facility including the two rest rooms.

Barbara Boal updated the group after speaking with Sonny Beeker and his crew to hopefully begin changes and upgrades in the restrooms as planned.

Nikki gave an overview of some upcoming events this season: we have a WEDDING sometime in June, a GRADUATION PARTY ON July 19 and also a WEDDING on AUGUST 1.

NIKKI ALSO UPDATED ON EVENTS THAT WILL BE TAKING PLACE AT THE "OCEAN PARK"

CRAIG UPDATED OUR GROUP ON SOME TOWN NEWS which was that the TOWN has gotten approval for a piece of property which is just south of the gas station. The owner has offered to allow the use of his property for parking when we have large events or just run out of parking places.

Craig also updated us in reference to "INLET DREDGING". He met with Representative Davis. It seems that Kure Beach is not responsible for the "INLET" and the Inlet will remain open.

Harriet made note that she has again gotten in touch to again have presentations with respect to "BIRDING ON OUR ISLAND". No dates were mentioned but members thought that perhaps those presentations would be best on Saturday mornings. More to come on this item....

There was some mention of a HALLOWEEN DANCE to be on OCTOBER 25. More information will be available around that time of year.

At this time there were many discussions having to do with our upcoming BAR-B-QUE. All members are asked to make desserts.

We also have many things to discuss in reference to the BBQ. We need NEW SIGNS and BANNERS, THIS HAS ALWAYS BEEN A POPULAR EVENT AND WE USUALLY GET QUITE A LARGE CROWD. THE CENTER WILL BE DISCUSSING WHAT SIGNS TO PUT UP AND WHERE TO HAVE THEM LOCATED. OUR SIGNS ARE GETTING OLD AND MESSED UP. NIKKI SAID THAT WE COULD HAVE ABOUT \$350 FOR GETTING NEW BANNERS AND CRAIG WILL ALSO BE LOOKING TO GET SIGNS, AND BANNERS. CRAIG WILL DISCUSS THIS WITH THE BOARD AND HOPEFULLY WE CAN HAVE NEW SIGNS AND BANNERS AROUND THE ISLAND FOR THIS EVENT. WE HOPE THAT CRAIG WILL BE SUCCESSFUL IN DISCUSSING OUR NEED FOR THE MONEY FOR NEW SIGNS. THE BARBECUE WILL TAKE PLACE ON THE 3RD SATURDAY IN AUGUST, AND THE TIMES 4 TO 8 P.M.

DISCUSSIONS TOOK PLACE BEFORE THE END OF OUR MEETING. NEW ITEMS FOR THE BARBEQUE ARE NEEDED. FOR INSTANCE, WE MAY NEED \$350 FOR NEW BANNERS. NIKKI MENTIONED THAT WE MAY NEED NEW BANNERS AS WELL AS OTHER SIGNAGE. BOTH NIKKI AND CRAIG WILL HELP GET NEW BANNERS. NIKKI THOUGHT THAT 3 BANNERS SHOULD BE

ENOUGH. SIGNS OR BANNERS WILL BE PLACED AT THE POST OFFICE, DOW ROAD, ALABAMA AVENUE, AND 3 SMALLER SIGNS.ALONG DOW ROAD. NIKKI AND CRAIG WILL BE VERY HELPFUL IN GETTING US ENOUGH MONEY FOR NEW FLAGS AND BANNERS FROM THE BOARD.
