

KURE BEACH COMMUNITY CENTER  
MINUTES MAY 12, 2015

Nancy Avery gave the town budget update. The proposed funds for community center improvements were removed due to funding changes for the town. The current proposed budget was reviewed with changes to move \$600.00 from plantings to upgrades. Upgrades would possibly include new front blinds and painting in the main floor area. The final budget will be voted upon June 30.

#### Old Business

Nikki thanked all the committee members who helped at the Street Festival. There are not many classes left for this year and two have been discontinued.

Hospice care approached the town about holding outreach programs on health care.

Craig reported that Kure Beach should recover well from the named storm, Anna, and will not need to use emergency money. Financially Kure Beach is in good shape citing the recent road improvements as an example. The local merchants

agreed to pay the majority of the monies on the free parking lot for summer guests.

He also reminded the committee that the fall elections have three seats up for reelection on the town council.

As the spring event such as the garden lecture and dance were not well attended the suggestion was made to set these events up in different locations. Ocean Front park was suggested as a possible location to attract greater exposure to the community at large. Another suggestion was made to rethink the programs and branch out to other events.
