

KURE BEACH COMMUNITY CENTER  
MEETING MINUTES  
June 9, 2015

The June 9<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Kure Beach Community Center came to order at 10:05. Members present were Mary Ann Mc Connell, Kathleen Zelinski, Jeannie Gordon, Harriet Owsley, Barbara Boal, Robin Sack, Nicole Keely, and Craig Blozinsky.

The suggestion was made to send the minutes via email for approval. Changes will be made electronically formal approval will take place at the following month's meeting. The May minutes were read and approved.

Jeannie reviewed the profit/cost statement for the 2014 BBQ. The BBQ netted a \$5.00 profit for every \$8.00 plate. The BBQ from Middle of the Island increased by .25 cents a pound which was absorbed. There was an increase in sales.

#### Old Business

Craig reported the beach nourishment would begin mid November. The area north of the pier up to Seawatch would not be impacted due to the land/sea profile. Because of the sand dunes the study stated that no sand was required.

The sales tax redistribution vote will come before the end of the month.

Traffic and parking during the Memorial Day holiday weekend hit saturation with many more day visitors who do not support the infrastructure. While there has been resistance to paid parking in the past this issue will be a future area to be addressed by the town.

Nikki said that weekly events are up at the Ocean Front Park. Turtle talks, Up and Active have good attendance. Yoga, Akito, and watercolor classes continue. Guitar camp begins the following week.

The main hall is now called the ballroom and a quote for painting was given. Nancy Avery is working on quotes for the blinds. A vote was taken and approval given for these expenses.

For the BBQ Middle of the Island raised the price to \$4.50 per pound. The committee voted and approved to raise the cost to \$9.00 per plate to cover increases.

Jeannie and Barb purchased most consumables with Robin purchasing desert plates and new salt/pepper sets. The sponsorship form is at the Kure Beach Lutheran Church. The committee wanted to continue to wear Hawaiian shirts while working during the BBQ. During the July meeting the silverware will be wrapped.

#### New Business

Harriet and Jeannie attended the Parks and Recreation meeting. They believed that the committees were not ready to merge.

Jeannie proposed we spend \$10.00 for a bookcase stand to support the new router and dispose of the pedestal. This was voted and approved.

The rose maintenance will be turned over to the town for trimming and weeding.

The meeting adjourned at 11:28. The next meeting is July 14.
