Approval of Minutes

Old/New Business

Town News-Craig

Town Hall has officially moved to Fort Fisher Air Force Recreation Area. All business will be conducted at the Recreation area while the new Town Hall is under construction.

A Storm Water Permit will have to be approved before the new construction is started.

The Annual KB Town Council Retreat will be held on Friday, 1/26/18 from 9am-4pm, at KB Community Center.

There will also be a Land Use Discussion before the construction begins.

Rental Updates-Nikki

Members received an updated Classes, Rentals, and Events Update for the KB Community Center.

Rental rate may be changed from hourly to a daily rate. This decision is still under consideration. Present rate is \$75/resident and \$100/nonresident. If charged hourly, staff members have to return frequently to open and close the facility during time of nonuse.
