The Shoreline Access and Parking Committee met on May 1st, 2007.

February 2006 CAMA Grants

The February 2006 CAMA Grant projects are on schedule and making progress.

- The Dept of Public Works will start installing bike racks this week. They also will be changing parking patterns at some of our Beach Accesses.
- Reimbursement for the ADA Parking Ramps has been received from CAMA. (\$48,767.49)
- The Community Parking Lot is nearly finished, with the exception of landscaping and signs.
- Although CAMA suggested putting the Restroom on K Ave. near the Pier the state did not allow a permit, therefore the Grant money will be returned to CAMA.

February 2007 CAMA Grant

Atlantic Avenue Boardwalk Extension

Final application to CAMA will be presented before May 22, 2007. Expected approval by August, and contract issued in September. Construction would start in October and finished by May.

K Ave Parking Extension

The Town Council returned the K Ave Parking Extension project back to the SLAP committee for further review. After discussion the committee is asking Engineering Services to redesign the previous plans, using more round-a-bouts with parking in the center lane. Side walks will be placed along town's right-a-ways from seventh to third Ave.

Porta Potties at Beach Accesses

The committee asked Sandi Whaley to be the project leader, to study the feasibility of putting Porta Potties at several beach accesses from May through September.

Corral Parking lot

Fred Tesh, project leader, reports progress is being made on the feasibility study of adding a K Ave entrance to the Corral parking lot.

Amendment to the Kure Beach Shoreline Access Plan

Peter Russo reported he had met with CAMA and has come up with a plan to amend the Beach Access Plan to remove the language that requires the need for nine more beach accesses. Peter was absent and will bring that plan to next meeting.

Joe Eakes Park ADA Sidewalk and Parking Improvements

The ADA committee and SLAP committee asked Sonny Beeker and Chuck Keener to present plans and costs to improve sidewalk and parking at Joe Eakes Park to be ADA compliant.
