- 6. Life guard stands. We have nine life guard stands and we are installing number signs on each stand and at the curb side.*
- 7. Goals for 2012 and 2013. The committee would like to survey all beach accesses for repairs oand or improvements.*
- 8. Public Works has received the "No Bird Feeding" and "No Dogs" signs and have installed them. The Public Beach Access signs are on order.*
- 9. The committee is still working on the redesigned signage on the beach front accesses with the Beach Protection Committee.*
