Old Business

Signs follow up

Both the Town Council and Sunny from Public Works are pleased with the proposed signs. Sunny will install signs and provide free labor but we must pay for materials such as poles etc. Dennis reports it will take 2 to 4 weeks to produce the signs and Sunny assured the committee it could be in place by Memorial Day. We would be ordering 14 signs. Reflective signs are \$385 per sign. Non Reflective signs are \$285 per sign. Sales Tax is to be added to the price quotes. Sunny asked if committee members would assist during installation to ensure they are being put in the correct place.

Discussion on changing our northern most beach access to handicapped access. Carolina Beach has rebuilt their southernmost access and has taken away the handicapped access. David pointed out the Town needs to make that decision quickly as we would then need to adjust the sign being ordered for that access point to reflect it is now a handicapped access site.

New Business

Town Council had requested this committee to come up with verbiage for the signs to be placed by the Dow underwater hazard site near the pier. After much discussion we are recommending the following

- For north/ south facing signs
Caution
Approaching
Underwater Hazard
- For east/west facing signs
Danger
Underwater Hazard

It was further recommended the Town discuss with their Attorney the best term to use between: Caution or Warning or Danger
