Old Business

- a. Adopt-a- Beach Update- Pat T reported 9 sections of the Beach are covered and the remaining 8 are pending
- b. Pat T also reported a decapitated Chicken was found between L & M Streets
- c. Signage update
 - Signs are being assembled by the Town as we speak.
 - Being installed using 6 x6 posts. Recommendation made to change mounting screws from Phillips to Hex head screws making them harder to remove
 - CAMA Permit pending. Letter has been sent to adjacent neighbors of the proposed sign placements. Expect permit in about 10 days. Installation to follow
 - Once installed sponsorship will be addressed at the following meeting
- d. Revised SLAP Brochure
 - David Garceau handed out a 1st draft of the new tri fold handout.
 - Suggestions were made for improvement
 - David reported obtaining a price to print and deliver at \$185/1000 or \$292/2500. Price includes folding and printing on 100 weight paper
 - David indicated he would work on the revisions of the tri fold for the next meeting
- e. Kure Beach Ocean Life Project
 - Dennis suggested we split the proposed program and in 2019 offer an educational program sponsored by this group but approved by the Council. The actual turtle watch to remain at this time with the Pleasure Island Turtle Project
 - It was pointed out by Joseph and Nancy, Turtle Watch was a requirement to continue the Corps of Engineers beach replenishment program.
 - It was decided Joseph would speak to Council for their input. Dennis would speak with the PI turtle Group. Bill would work on Goals and objectives for a separate program. David would also help with the preparation for the proposed program.

New Business

- Bill mentioned he was meeting with CAMA that Friday to seek approval on a new plan for sandbags at Ocean Dunes
- Bill also mentioned he was going on front of the Town P & Z commission to discuss issues with Propane tanks on the Ocean Side of ocean front structures
