Meeting was called to order by Chairman Panicali at 5:00PM in the Temporary Town Hall.

Old Business

Adopt-a-Bach

Pat T had no updates and advised that the beach seemed to be in good shape. The issue was raised about the lack of a UNCW Beach sweep, which has occurred in the past. Some ideas were suggested for local civic groups that might be interested in doing a “sweep” this season. Additionally, it was suggested that perhaps the local residents would be solicited to do a dweep.

Beach Booster

Ed did not have an update from last meeting, nor a “mock-up” prepared but one has been promised prior to the next meeting. Southern Signs will be asked to provide a cost “per panel” and some loose ideas were discussed about the design. Cost of the sponsorship was discussed with a suggestion of \$200 for initial fee discussed (which would include the cost of the sign). Final numbers will be done once we know the cost of the sign panels.

Flyers

David emailed the committee shortly before the meeting a final draft of the new flyers that would be distributed. David advised the pricing would be \$185.00 for 1,000 and \$292.00 for 2500. Some suggestions for distribution were discussed but the implementation has tabled until the spring – closer to the rental season of 2019.

Ocean Beach Project

Pat mentioned that she has the verbal commitments of several people who want to be ambassadors. An early idea would be to have 3 different varieties of beach walks/talks. Some of the potential topics would be: wildlife, dunes, litter, tides/currents, history. The inclusion of some experts was discussed (Spencer Rogers on dunes for example). More information is being formalized for presentation to the Town Council.

TOKB Liason

Joseph reported that there was no change to the parking rules and beach parking maybe permanently added to locations where informal parking presently takes place.

New Business

KB App

Joseph mentioned that the idea of developing an app for the town has been discussed informally. The app would include information for local and visitors and provide emergency alerts.
