

**Stormwater Committee Meeting 1/08/2008 Minutes**

The Stormwater Committee met on 1/08/2008 in the Town Hall Council room at 5:00pm.

Attending were committee members Karen Vadr, Vinney Doran, Ted Gragg and Eric Vann. Dean Lambeth, council liaison and Michelle James, Town Administrator also were in attendance.

The following items were discussed:

1. Stormwater Landscaping Informational Session -

Karen Vadr gave an update on the committee sponsored program to be held at the aquarium on January 29 from 3 to 5 pm. Peggy Sloan, Aquarium Educational Coordinator and Ryan Bradshaw a Kure Beach Landscape Designer will be the speakers. Karen is to mail our invitations to area landscapers and all residents are invited to attend. Program will require preregistration with Karen so attendees can gain free admission to Aquarium. Information will appear in the upcoming Town Newsletter.

2. Beachwalk Request for Retention Pond Maintenance Funding Assistance

After some discussion a motion was made and carried unanimously that the committee recommends that the council not participate in in funding of Beachwalk or any other privately owned retention pond at this time.

The committee recognized that public waters to go into most of the retention ponds in the town and at some time in the future the town may want to entertain the possible assumption of maintenance of these ponds under very specific conditions including deeded easements and ponds being brought up to design standards.

3. Stormwater Management Program Assessment(SWMPA) - (Phase I and II NPDES Permits Annual Reports)

Eric Vann had copy of the annual report form (31 pages) which is to be completed on line as well as the instructions for filling out the form (16 pages). This report is for the one year period from March 1, 2007 to February 28, 2008 and is due within 60 days of end of permit year. The town's phase II permit has some specific items that have to be completed within the first 5 years of the original permit. Eric has had DWQ in Raleigh to set the Town up on the on line reporting system and has volunteered to assist Sonny Beeker and others in completing this required report.
