Hazardous Waste Pickup	County said they would try to get one on the island once a year. Paint will be accepted when dried with kitty litter. ML spoke with Spectrum paint and will keep up to date.		
Dog Waste	Barko provides for Barking Lot at Joe Eakes Park. \$408 for new Barko. Muttmitt special kit for canstand and receptacle for \$150 and \$89 for the replacement bags up till June 6. Zero waste CB State Park \$279 for stations. All biodegradable. TG suggested checking with WM. Where would we put them? Public Property - Water tower on Settlers, corner of KB Way and Ft Fisher (pump station) N and Ft Fisher Blvd inlet side, median corners 4-5 stations less than \$1,000 and bags will be 2,000 for \$700-\$800	JG to check with NA to check with Waste Mangement. Grants	Clean Water Trust Fund Grant – EV outflows (new and innovative Stormwater) CW must spend current funds at park before they will give more. Can we start preparing for application process that requires engineer. Public Works must have \$ built into budget for engineer to write grant. Sonny not starting on Phase 2 till 2014 with Phase 3 another 10 years. EV suggested DOT to prepare grants. Concern about pipes that may cave in and flooding presented by Sonny to the committee last year.
