Can we turn it east and back to the road? • Yard waste issue? Taken to Diverse Biomass on Sunnyvale Rd. \$20 a ton. (\$2,000.00 spent last year including free pick up week.) • Sunnypoint wants us to move our lay down area. May have to change current operations. • Recycling increased and working well. Tipping fees down. • Question from JT, "If a private citizen has a problem with their Stormwater system and they need something done how do they do it?"
