Committee Minutes

September 13, 2022

Call to Order: Meeting was called to order @ 9:30am by John Salanski. Additional members present were: Christine Burrows, Ellen Owens and Gerald Stavias. Also in attendance was Nikki Keely.

Approval of Minutes: Approved minutes from the August 9, 2022 meeting.

Town News: No new town news – Mayor not present. Nikki mentioned that the boardwalk is on the next Town Council agenda. Gerald asked a general question. Did anyone else receive the letter from Chemours about testing their water? Was KB municipal water tested? Nikki does not know and recommended that he reach out to public works. Ellen mentioned that it would be the State of NC DENR that would have done the testing.

Recreation Report: Nikki provided an updated schedule of classes, rentals and events calendar. Per Christine, the Heglar Open already have 30 participants signed up. Maxed out due to number of tennis courts available.

Are we going to build pickleball courts? Per Nikki, not on the schedule yet. Next FY conversations will not start until January 2023. Resurfacing of tennis courts is budgeted this FY. JEP has limited space for new facilities and changes.

Community Center Business: Ellen asked Nikki if she had the chance to follow up with the New Hanover County Health Department regarding the cookie exchange taking place at the Community Center. She was told that falls under the of the Department of Agriculture. She called and left a message but has not heard back from them. John to talk with prior volunteers about the supplies needed to make the globes. He will follow up with this committee at our next meeting. Confirmed that the event will be from 1-4pm, Sunday, December 4, 2023. Open house. Ellen to work up information/flyer with details that will be used for promoting, etc. Discuss details and begin promoting after the October committee meeting.

Christmas town event was officially cancelled. Will continue with the Grinch event this year.

KB does not have a golf cart parade. The CB parade is the Friday after Thanksgiving. KB not directly involved however the KPD and KFD assist.

Filming – can only charge what is in the fee schedule. Film permits, impact fees, additional services such as hiring PD staff, barricades, etc.

Summarized the Lighted Globe/Cookie Exchange details –

- Need the size, grade, and amount of chicken wire needed for each globe. Discussed how that would be paid for. Reimburse for materials with receipt or Nikki can purchase.
- Cost to participate and or bring canned goods for the Food Bank.
- Number of cookies to bring. One to one exchange suggested so that people are both sharing and receiving. Recommend at least 1 dozen. 2-3 per share individually wrapped. Bring recipe.
- Alcohol? Would have to go to council for approval. Can only be beer or wine. No liquor.
- What other beverages?
- Music – John and Bluetooth speaker
- Hosting/collecting money, etc.
