

## **Kure Beach Community Center**

### **Committee Minutes**

**October 11, 2022**

**Call to Order:** Meeting was called to order at 9:30 am by John Shalanski. Committee members in attendance were Christine Burrows, Linda Collora, Ellen Owens, Gerald Stavlas. Additional attendees included Mayor Craig Bloszinsky and Recreational Director Nikki Keely.

**Approval of Minutes:** Minutes were approved for September 13<sup>th</sup> session.

**Town News:** Mayor provided updates around daily well water testing, parking and planning. Of special note, there is a parking proposal being presented to town council on 10/11 to review Kure Beach and Carolina Beach residents parking pass which will be honored in both towns. Beach nourishment project did impact parking revenue during the summer season. Additionally, Riverlights community across the bridge is advertising “beach life without the cost” to attract new residents. These are just a few of the notations for consideration of the parking proposal. Slope of roofs for new construction is also being reviewed with an update expected at a later date.

**Recreation Planning:** Nikki provided update on recreation and community center scheduling.

**Community Center Business:** The Lighted Globe and Cookie Exchange event (to be formally renamed when flyer goes out) will be held on December 4<sup>th</sup> with committee approving the date. Committee also aligned on \$5 plus canned good item for the entry fee to offset cost of materials for the chicken wire. Fine tuned cookie exchange details and flyer for release in next Kure Beach news email. Committee voted unanimously to approve the applications of William Wickliffe and Susan Hale Mckibbin for full time membership to the Community Center Committee and will forward their applications to the KB Town Council for confirmation at the October 24<sup>th</sup> Council Meeting.

**Adjournment:** Meeting was adjourned at 10:30 am. The next meeting will take place earlier than scheduled to accommodate Election Day week set up and voting hours. Meeting will now take place on **November 1** at 9:30 am in the Town Hall meeting room.
