In 1997 we signed the initial agreement for 20 years, the Core of Engineers is requiring that we offer season passes for parking to visitors as well as residents. Beach nourishment is a federally funded event, so we need to make it beneficial to visitors. The mayor will be sending out an email in the next day or two.

- **Turtle Friendly Street lights** Dennis The turtle friendly streetlights are scheduled to be installed between 11/19 12/6/24.

- Dunes Dennis The Town did a great job of repairing the dune and access at H Ave. Sea Oats and Grass planting in this area may be something this committee can take on. Beach Grass gets planted in February and the Sea Oats in May.
- **Beach Signage** Randy Rick shared that there are a couple of signs down. DPW is down by four people and will be down five as of this week. They are aware of the signs being down and will get to it as soon as possible.
