INSTALLATION OF SIDEWALK ON NORTH SIDE OF K AVENUE

II. OPENING AND PURPOSE OF HEARING – Mayor Lambeth

The purpose of this public hearing is to receive public comments on the proposed installation of a sidewalk on the north side of K Avenue from Third Avenue to Settlers Lane.

On September 20, 2011, Council adopted Resolution R11-17 authorizing \$15,000 from the Powell Bill Funds as matching funds for the Department of Transportation to install the sidewalk.

Council held a public hearing on October 18, 2011.

Notice of the public hearing was posted at Town Hall on October 26, 2011 and advertised in the Island Gazette on November 9, 2011. Written notice of the hearing was mailed to all property owners on K Avenue on October 26, 2011.

The sidewalk will begin ten (10) feet from the street and will be five (5) feet in width. There will be no curbing.
