2. Rescheduled the Town Council Meeting on Monday, January 20, 2025 for the Martin Luther King Holiday to Tuesday, January 21, 2025
3. Scheduled the 2025 Town Council Retreat on Monday, February 3, 2025 at 9:00 a.m.
4. Agreed to pay \$2,500 to remove the Guard Shack at Kure Beach Village HOA, the HOA is responsible for the other \$1,700(to demolish and dispose of retaining wall, Kure Beach Village signage and plantings/landscaping/dirt)
5. Approved the Parking Season as follows:
  - Beginning/ End of Parking Season: 3/15 to 9/30 (same as last year)
  - Hourly Rate: \$6.00
  - Daily Rate: \$25.00
  - Weekly Rate: \$125.00
  - Business Employee Rate: \$75.00
  - Season Permit:
    - 2/1-2/8 - \$50
    - 2/9-2/28 - \$100
    - 3/1-9/30 \$225
  - Marked Handicap spaces are free parking with Handicap Placard or license plate
  - Purple Heart Recipients with a Purple Heart license plate may park for free in any marked space
  - Church parking on Sunday from 8:00 am to 1:00 pm is free at the following locations:
    - 3rd Avenue, between K Avenue and L Avenue
    - 6th Avenue between I Avenue and J Avenue
    - KB Community Center Parking (118 N 3rd Avenue)
