- 3. Scheduled the 2025 Town Council Retreat on Monday, February 3. 2025 at 9:00 a.m.
- 4. Agreed to pay \$2,500 to remove the Guard Shack at Kure Beach Village HOA, the HOA is responsible for the other \$1,700(to demolish and dispose of retaining wall, Kure Beach Village signage and plantings/landscaping/dirt)
